		<i>Jacob Boesel attended the public schools of New Bremen and later attended St. Marys public schools for 2 years, where he learned the English language. In the fall of 1856, he began his mercantile career at St. Marys, where he was employed as clerk for 2 years at the store of Joseph Kelsey. In 1858, after going to Bartlett's Commercial College in Cincinnati, Jacob Boesel returned to New Bremen and took charge of his father's business. Jacob graduated from Bartlett's in 1860 and in 1866, he went into merchandising for himself with C.H. Kunning.</i>	<i>In 1870, Jacob's brother, Charles (Jr.), was included in the firm and they then took charge of the pork &amp; grain trade which their father had established. The firm of Boesel &amp; Kunning was also engaged in the hardware business - until 1891, when Charles (Jr.) withdrew from the firm and took over that part of the business. Upon the death of their father in 1885, Jacob became president of his father's bank, which was reorganized under the name of Boesel Bros. &amp; Co. and later changed to Boesel's Bank. Boesel &amp; Kunning continued business until 4/1/1893, when Jacob withdrew to devote his entire attention to the banking business. Jacob was president of the bank until his death.</i>	<i>Jacob Boesel held the positions of Township Clerk (6 yrs.), City Clerk (4 yrs.), Mayor (4 yrs.), President of the School Board (4 yrs.) and member (6 yrs.). In 1889, he was elected to represent Auglaize County in the State Legislature and was re-elected in 1891. (He served on the finance, Library &amp; Deaf &amp; Dumb Asylum Committees during both terms.) He was president of the first building &amp; loan association founded in N.B. and when the Citizens Building &amp; Loan Assoc. was started, he became president of it. He was also president of the N.B. Natural Gas Co. from the time it was organized. 171 rigs came to the cemetery for Jacob Boesel's burial.</i>

For many years he also was vice president of the First National Bank, which purchased the First City Bank on January 16, 1908.</i>	<i>For some 30 years, Adolph was a director of the Citizens' Building &amp; Loan Assoc. and was its president when he died. He also was a director &amp; president of the N.B. Broom Co. The only public office he ever held was that of city treasurer for some 30 years.</i>
